I. What are your reasons for wanting to return to Camp Outlook?

II. For 2017-18 we are continuing to run overnight trips in the fall and exclusively day trips in the winter for camper and staff moral. Reflecting on your two winter projects from last year what would you do differently and what do you look forward to trying this year?

III. How do you expect your role as a returning staff to differ from your previous year or years? What action do you want to take to further improve Outlook?

IV. Being a returning staff can present new opportunities for leadership. In what areas would you be interested in taking a position of increased leadership? What can you contribute to our “collective knowledge” at Outlook? (perhaps fundraising in the community, leading training sessions, sharing past experiences, teaching, organising new winter day trips, or innovation within committees etc...)
